Areas 11 & 13 Combined Training Qualifiers

For teams of four, two compete in the prelim/75 section and two in the novice/85 section. Those entering as members of a team will also compete as individuals. Individuals not in a team may also enter either one of the sections.

Dressage test:	BRC HT90 Q (2013)	BRC HT100 Q (2013)
Show Jumping:	0.75m	0.85m

The Challenge will involve a round of 7 – 10 show jumping obstacles and 15 – 25 cross country jumping efforts. Sections will run concurrently and not necessarily in order of A - F.

Course walking: The course may be walked from 2.00 – 6.00 p.m. on Friday 5th October

Helpers: It is a condition of entry that each Club entering the Challenge supply two helpers per team. Clubs within Area 11 who are entering a team in the combined training must supply one helper per team. Please supply helpers name(s) and contact details with the entry form.

The horse's passport/flu certificate must accompany the horse on the day of the competition and be taken to the Secretary's office on arrival.

Substitutions must be made in writing (by e-mail acceptable up to no later than noon on 5th)

DIRECTIONS SatNav users: use postcode GU7 1XA

If coming from the M25, go south down the A3 past all Guildford turnings (IGNORE Sat Nav as it will take you through the middle of Guildford). Take the turning to Godalming and Guildford Crematorium. Take signs to Godalming Town Centre and then pick up signs for Cranleigh (B2130). At the traffic lights near Waitrose in Godalming go straight on. At the next set of traffic lights turn left onto the B2130 (signposted Cranleigh and Winkworth Arboretum). Go up hill past all the parked cars and over speed bumps. At the pedestrian crossing by the church slow down, go over one more speed bump and turn left into Heath Lane (IGNORE SAT NAV as it will take you straight on). It is narrow (but plenty big enough for a horsebox) and is very easy to go straight past. Go down the lane and take the first left into Heath Farm.

If coming north on the A3, come off at the Milford exit. Follow signs for Godalming. Pick up signs for Cranleigh and the B2130. Turn right at the second large set of traffic lights in Godalming onto the B2130 (signposted Cranleigh and Winkworth Arboretum). Follow directions as above. If coming from Horsham on the A281, follow signs for Godalming and approach from the Godalming direction as the turn into Heath Farm from the Cranleigh end of the B2130 is blind and is too tight for a lorry without doing a three point turn in the middle of the road!
