Introduction

BRC are delighted to be able to host this virtual dressage championship. The competition will be run online and will consist of those qualified in the rescheduled 2020 and 2021 Novice and Intermediate dressage championships, both teams and individuals. Competitors will film themselves riding their tests (details of tests below) and then send BRC the link. This will be then collated and sent to a British Dressage Judge. The judge will watch the link and judge the test as they would if they were attending a competition. The top 3 competitors in each arena will then be shown on our social media page with results being published after they have been shown.

Rules and Regulations

This competition will run under British Riding Club rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes document which can be found via the link below: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook>.

Entries

Entries are by invitation only and will have been sent to the team manager on the declaration sheet from the qualifier. Entries close Friday 19 March.

Eligibility

Competitors must be 2021 members to compete in these championships.

Competitors who qualified in 2020 must be a member of the same club they qualified for as a 2021 member.

Changes

Changes are permitted as per normal championships – there must be 2 original horse and rider combinations in a team of 4 or 1 original horse and rider combination in a team of 3. Changes must be submitted no later than 29 March.

Flu Vaccinations

Vaccinations will not be required to be within 6 months and 21 days of the championship. However, vaccinations must still be correct in accordance to G7.1 in the current BRC Handbook for the primary course and 12 month vaccinations. Spot checks will be carried out so you may be required to email a copy of your horses full flu vaccination record.

This decision was made due to competitors not travelling to these championships, drastically reducing the risk as horses will not be mixing at a venue from all over the UK.

Arena

To record your test, you will need a 20m x 40m arena, either in a menage or on grass. The arena does not need to be enclosed but markers should be placed at each of the letters around the outside of the arena. This can be by using letter markers or homemade markers such as a cones or poles.

Video Submissions

Recorded tests must be received no later than Wednesday 31 March by email to brcentries@bhs.org.uk. Details of how to submit the test will be sent to team managers and will be available on the website.

Payment

Payment for entries can be made via the online entry booking system <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/select> or over the phone on 02476 840518. If you are not able to pay in this way, please contact HQ and we will organise an alternative. Entry prices are as follows:

Refund Policy

If a team or individual have to withdraw before the closing date and the space can be filled, a refund may be issued at the discretion of BRC. If the space cannot be filled, or the withdrawal is after the closing date, then no refund will be issued.

Dress code

Full competition dress is required. Horses must not be wearing boots, or any tack not permitted in a dressage or riding test. Any incorrect tack will result in a deduction of 2 marks per item. For a full list of permitted tack, please see appendix 4 of the current BRC Handbook. Hats must be up to the current standard as shown in appendix 4 of the current BRC Handbook. It is the competitors responsibility to ensure that any untagged hats are up to the correct standard.

Competitor numbers will not be assigned so theses do not need to be worn.

Dressage tests

Due to running online, the tests for the championships have changed to BRC tests. Please use the table below to work out what test you will be riding at the championships based on what test you rode at the qualifier.

BRC tests are being used for these championships as they can be used electronically and therefore be sent out via email once the section is complete, cutting out excessive postage due to the number of arenas and entries. BD tests are being used for a selection of arenas due to BRC only having limited tests available. Whilst we have made some new tests for 2021, we were unable produce more in the timeframe required.

Please see below the tests being used for each championship alongside the tests used for the qualifier, so you are able to see which test you will be riding for the

championships. For confirmation of which test you will be riding, please see the BRC website where a competitor list will be published. This will not be posted before the week commencing 15 February.

Results

Full results from all arenas will be posted on the BRC website. The top 3 in each arena will be streamed the week commencing 26 April (full schedule of streaming will be released nearer the time). Scoring will be as the BRC Handbook.

Whilst BRC would like to be able to stream the top 10 tests in each arena, this is not feasible due to the number of arenas (up to 64) and entries required to run all of the classes for these championships.

Scoresheets will be sent to the team manager once the arena is complete by email.

Scoring queries

There will be a 24-hour objection period which will be specified in the email with the scoresheet attached once an arena is complete. Please note that each arena will be sent at different times, so the objection periods will differ and you may not receive all of your competitor scoresheets at the same time.

Rosettes and Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded to the top 10 teams and individuals in each section. Prizes will be awarded in kind from SEIB Insurance Brokers and Horsehage & Mollichaff and will vary between the classes.

Competition timeline

- Deadline for qualifiers to run – 14 March
- Deadline for results to be received by HQ – 15 March
- Championship entries close – 19 March
- Deadline for changes – 29 March
- Deadline for video submissions – 31 March
- Deadline for judging to be complete – 11 April
- BRC to have sent all scoresheets – 20 April
- Top 3 of each arena playback – W/C 26 April, timetable TBC
- Results for each section will be published following the playback for that arena. Team results will be posted upon completion of the championship playback
